Sustainability

Arrow squid are a group distinguished by short arrow-like tail fins. They tend to concentrate in areas of nutrient-rich upwelling waters, where they feed on plankton, small fish and other squids. The two *Notodarus* species in New Zealand waters are white with bronze tones on the mantle and head. The two species of arrow squid are quite short-lived – after about a year, they spawn and then die – and abundance is highly variable between years. Due to these factors, it is difficult to predict future stock size, but at present stock are not endangered and the fisheries are well managed.
