Patagonian Toothfish, commercially known as Chilean Sea Bass, is not an endangered species but it is illegally fished quite regularly. It is a slow-growing, deepwater fish that reproduces late in life – traits that make it vulnerable to overfishing.

It is available in most markets, but the onus is on restaurateurs to obtain legal and documented product.
